**SAMPLE SIZE:** 800 respondents agreed to participate.

SAMPLE SELECTION: Random sampling of nationwide landline phone numbers,

requesting an adult over 15 who owns a mobile phone. If more

than one at home, the person who has the next birthday.

SAMPLE ERROR: Based on this sample of 800 respondents, the maximum

sampling error (for a score of 50%) is +/- 3.5%, at the 95%

confidence level.



While most people said that a party promising to lower their mobile phone costs would not affect their vote, a significant 15% said they would be more likely to vote for a party that reduced the termination rate, and only 1% said they were less likely.
